NEW TREASURY TEAM!

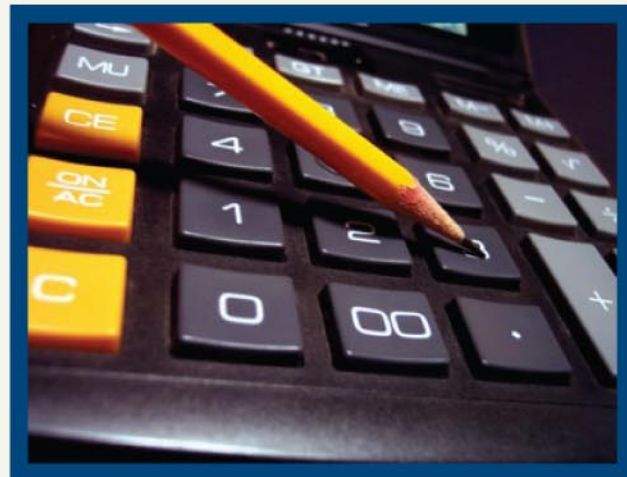
