During my year as your leader I'd like to focus our energies in the following six areas:

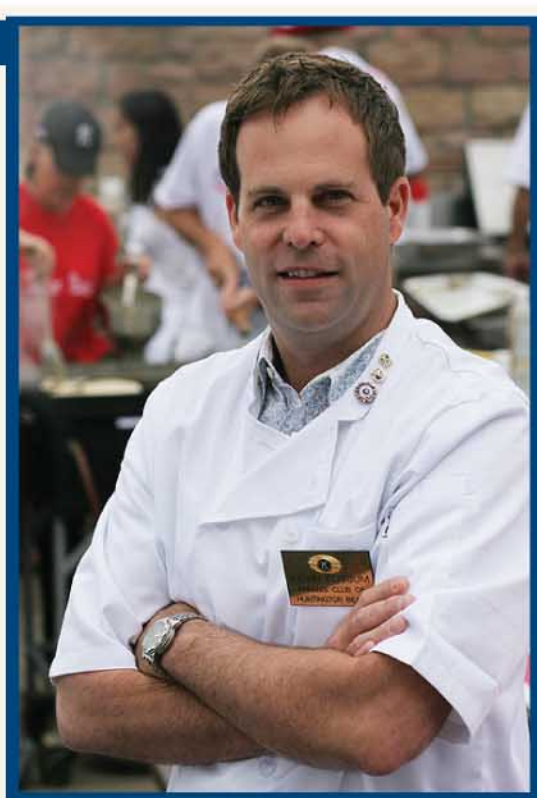
1. Support our Sponsored Leadership Programs (Key Club, KKids, etc.)
